

1 AN ACT relating to firefighters and making an appropriation therefor.

2 ***Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:***

3 ➔Section 1. KRS 95A.210 is amended to read as follows:

4 As used in KRS 95A.200 to 95A.300, unless the context otherwise requires:

- 5 (1) "Commission" means the Commission on Fire Protection Personnel Standards and
6 Education established pursuant to KRS 95A.020;
- 7 (2) "Established work schedule" means a work schedule adopted by or required of a
8 local government setting a recurring pattern for time on and off duty for
9 professional firefighters employed by the local government. An established work
10 schedule includes but is not limited to a schedule of twenty-four (24) consecutive
11 hours on duty, followed by forty-eight (48) consecutive hours off duty;
- 12 (3) "Executive director" means the executive director of the Commission on Fire
13 Protection Personnel Standards and Education;
- 14 (4) "Fund" means Firefighters Foundation Program Fund;
- 15 (5) "Local government" means any city, county, urban-county government, charter
16 county government, unified local government, consolidated local government, *air*
17 *board created under KRS Chapter 183,* or any combination thereof of the
18 Commonwealth;
- 19 (6) "Professional firefighter" means any member of a paid municipal fire department
20 organized under KRS Chapter 95, 67A, or 67C, a fire protection district organized
21 under KRS Chapter 75, or a county fire department created pursuant to KRS
22 Chapter 67, *or any firefighter employed by an air board created under KRS*
23 *Chapter 183;*
- 24 (7) "Program" means the Alan "Chip" Terry Professional Development and Wellness
25 Program for firefighters established in KRS 95A.292;
- 26 (8) "Scheduled overtime" means work by a professional firefighter in excess of forty
27 (40) hours per week which regularly recurs as part of an established work schedule;

- 2 (9) "Unscheduled overtime" means work by a professional firefighter in excess of forty
- 3 (40) hours per week which does not regularly recur as part of an established work
- 4 schedule.
