## Education - Harford County - Liability of School Bus Contractors

- 3 FOR the purpose of establishing that an entity operating a school bus under a contract with 4 the Harford County Board of Education to provide student transportation services 5 may not be held liable beyond the limits of the Harford County Board of Education's 6 insurance coverage through the Maryland Association of Boards of Education in any 7 suit that arises from a vehicular accident or an act or omission of an officer, a 8 director, or an employee of the entity, except if the act or omission constitutes gross 9 negligence, reckless, willful, or wanton misconduct, or intentionally tortious conduct; providing for the application of this Act; and generally relating to student 10 11 transportation services in Harford County.
