- WHEREAS, the Treeing Walker Coonhound is a native Kentucky dog breed,
- 3 developed in the 19th century by two Kentucky breeders, John W. Walker and George
- 4 Washington Maupin; and
- 5 WHEREAS, the Treeing Walker Coonhound is a hunting breed known to chase
- 6 quarry into trees, thus giving hunters a clear shot at game; and
- WHEREAS, the Treeing Walker Coonhound is known for hunting raccoons, but is
- 8 also used for hunting other game, including animals ranging in size from rodents to bears;
- 9 and
- WHEREAS, Treeing Walker Coonhounds are fast, sensible hunters with clear,
- 11 ringing bugle voices; and
- WHEREAS, Treeing Walker Coonhounds locate their quarry quickly by following
- the freshest scent available, and they also exhibit superb endurance; and
- WHEREAS, Treeing Walker Coonhounds are also great companion dogs, known
- for their loyalty and intelligence, kindness to children, and ability to get along with other
- 16 dogs; and
- WHEREAS, the Treeing Walker Coonhound became a recognized breed of the
- American Kennel Club in January 2012, and referenced by the AKC as "the people's
- 19 choice" among coonhounds;
- NOW, THEREFORE,
- Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
- 22 → SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 2 IS CREATED TO
- 23 READ AS FOLLOWS:
- 24 The Treeing Walker Coonhound is named and designated as the official state dog of
- 25 Kentucky.
