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12	WHEREAS, a comprehensive study of the operation and

18	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
19	HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That there is created the Study
20	Commission on the Operation and Funding of the Surface Mining
21	Commission and the Department of Labor, Abandoned Mine
22	Program.
23	(a) The membership of the commission shall consist
24	of the following:
25	(1) Two members of the House of Representatives
26	appointed by the Speaker.

1 (2) Two members of the Senate appointed by the 2 President Pro Tempore.

- 3 (3) One representative of the coal industry
  4 appointed by the member appointed by the Speaker of the House
  5 of Representatives.
  - (4) One representative of the coal industry appointed by the member appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate.
    - (5) One representative of the Department of Labor.
  - (6) One representative of the Surface Mining Commission.
  - (b) The appointing authorities shall coordinate their appointments to assure that the membership of the Study Commission on the Operation and Funding of the Surface Mining Commission and the Department of Labor, Abandoned Mine Program is inclusive and reflects the racial, gender, geographic, urban, rural, and economic diversity of the state.
  - (c) The commission shall have all of the following
    duties:
  - (1) Perform a complete and comprehensive review and assessment of state laws and regulations regarding the operation and funding of the Surface Mining Commission and the Department of Labor, Abandoned Mine Program, including any statistical data available.
  - (2) Identify issues in the law or administrative rules that open gaps or create problems regarding the operation and funding process.

1 (3) Identify problem areas, programs, and cost
2 efficiencies through systematic data collection and analysis.

- (4) Identify innovative programs and strategies used in other states that have proven to be effective or have shown promise to improve the operation and funding process in this industry.
- (5) Submit recommendations for legislative actions to the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the President Pro Tempore of the Senate during the first week of the 2018 Regular Session at which time the commission shall be dissolved.
- (d)(1) Appointments to the commission shall be made within 30 days after the effective date of this act.
- (2) The commission shall hold its first meeting no later than August 1, 2017, with the date, time, and location of the meeting designated by the Speaker of the House of Representatives.
- (3) At the first meeting, the commission shall elect a chair, vice chair, and other officers as determined by the commission, and shall set dates, times, and locations of subsequent meetings.
- (e) The House of Representatives and the Senate shall provide the necessary staff and support to the commission to perform its duties.
- (f) Members of the commission shall serve without compensation but may be reimbursed for necessary expenses in

attending meetings of the commission according to the policies and procedures of their respective appointing authority.

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- (g) Legislative members of the commission shall be entitled to their legislative compensation, per diem, and travel expenses for each day they attend a meeting of the commission in accordance with Amendment 871 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901.
- 8 (h) A copy of this resolution shall be provided to all appointing authorities of the commission.
