A BILL

To delay the effectiveness of certain new rules or regulations relating to the United States energy sector.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Gas Prices Relief Act
- 5 of 2022".

1 SEC. 2. ENERGY REGULATIONS HOLIDAY.

2	(a) In General.—During the period described in
3	subsection (b), no Federal agency shall finalize any rule
4	or regulation that would cause—
5	(1) a decrease in domestic oil, gas, or biofuels
6	production;
7	(2) an increase in gasoline prices; or
8	(3) any negative effects on domestic energy pro-
9	duction, domestic electricity generation, transmission
10	of fuel or electricity, infrastructure development, or
11	transportation fuels.
12	(b) Period Described.—The period referred to in
13	subsection (a) is the period beginning on the date of enact-
14	ment of this Act and ending on the earlier of—
15	(1) January 1, 2023; and
16	(2) the date on which the national average con-
17	sumer gasoline price is \$2.60 per gallon or less.
