- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 17 PART V. STATE FUNDING.
- 18 **20–217.**
- 19 (A) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, NO STATE
- 20 FUNDS MAY BE USED TO PAY FOR AN ABORTION PROCEDURE OR HEALTH BENEFITS
- 21 COVERAGE THAT INCLUDES COVERAGE OF ABORTION PROCEDURES.

- 1 (B) THE PROHIBITION IN SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION DOES NOT 2 APPLY IF:
- 3 (1) The woman's pregnancy is the result of an act of rape or 4 incest; or
- 5 (2) THE WOMAN HAS A LIFE-ENDANGERING PHYSICAL CONDITION
- 6 CAUSED BY OR ARISING FROM THE PREGNANCY ITSELF THAT WOULD, AS CERTIFIED
- 7 BY A PHYSICIAN, PLACE THE WOMAN IN DANGER OF DEATH UNLESS AN ABORTION IS
- 8 PERFORMED.
- 9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 10 October 1, 2017.
