# A BILL

## **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Protecting America's
- 5 Strategic Petroleum Reserve from China Act".

1	SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON SALES OF PETROLEUM PROD-
2	UCTS FROM THE STRATEGIC PETROLEUM RE-
3	SERVE TO CHINA.
4	Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Sec-
5	retary of Energy shall not draw down and sell petroleum
6	products from the Strategic Petroleum Reserve—
7	(1) to any entity that is under the ownership or
8	control of the Chinese Communist Party or the Peo-
9	ple's Republic of China; or
10	(2) except on the condition that such petroleum
11	products will not be exported to the People's Repub-
12	lic of China.
