A BILL

To make funds available for fisheries resource disaster assistance for the 2015–16 Dungeness crab and rock crab fisheries disaster, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Crab Emergency Dis-
- 5 aster Assistance Act of 2017".
- 6 SEC. 2. FISHERY RESOURCE DISASTER ASSISTANCE FOR
- 7 THE 2015-16 DUNGENESS CRAB AND ROCK
- 8 CRAB FISHERIES DISASTER.
- 9 (a) DISASTER ASSISTANCE.—

- 1 (1) APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS.—In addition to
 2 any other funds available for such purpose, there is
 3 appropriated to the Secretary of Commerce
 4 \$117,393,750 to make a lump sum payment to the
 5 Pacific States Marine Fisheries Commission.
 - (2) DISTRIBUTION.—The Commission shall distribute such amount among fishing communities, Indian Tribes, small businesses, including fishermen, fish processors, and related businesses, individuals, and other entities, for assistance for the economic and social effects of the fishery resource disaster for the 2015–16 Dungeness crab and rock crab fisheries as determined by the Secretary of the Commerce on January 18, 2017, and to mitigate the economic losses to such communities, Tribes, businesses, individuals, or other entities caused by fishing closures or other restrictions on the harvesting of Dungeness crab or rock crab.
 - (3) AVAILABILITY.—Amounts appropriated by this subsection shall remain available for the period with respect to which the determination referred to in paragraph (2) is made.
 - (4) Unused funds.—Any amount appropriated by this subsection that is not expended or otherwise obligated for the purpose described in

1	paragraph (1) shall be returned to the Treasury of
2	the United States.
3	(b) Research.—
4	(1) APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS.—There is ap-
5	propriated to the Secretary of Commerce—
6	(A) \$1,000,000 for West Coast domoid
7	acid sampling and monitoring; and
8	(B) \$5,000,000 for competitive grants for
9	projects, activities, and research that advance
10	the capacity—
11	(i) to predict the occurrence of harm-
12	ful algal blooms in the offshore waters of
13	California, Washington, and Oregon; and
14	(ii) to evaluate the toxicity of domoic
15	acid bioaccumulation and transmission to
16	humans through the food supply.
17	(2) Establishment of grant program.—
18	The Secretary shall establish a grant program with
19	amounts appropriated by paragraph (1)(B) not later
20	than 90 days after the date of the enactment of this
21	Act.
22	(c) Limitation on Administrative Expenses.—
23	The Secretary of Commerce may not use more than 4 per-

- 1 cent of the amount appropriated under each of subsections
- 2 (a) and (b) for administrative expenses.

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
