A BILL

To prohibit the use of Federal funds to install permanent fencing around the United States Supreme Court Building or grounds.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "No Fencing at the
- 5 United States Supreme Court Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. PROHIBITING USE OF FUNDS FOR PERMANENT
- 7 FENCING AROUND UNITED STATES SUPREME
- 8 COURT BUILDING OR GROUNDS.
- 9 (a) Prohibition.—No Federal funds may be used
- 10 to install permanent fencing around—

1	(1) the perimeter of the United States Supreme
2	Court Building; or
3	(2) the perimeter of the Supreme Court
4	grounds, or any portion thereof, described in section
5	6101(b) of title 40, United States Code.
6	(b) Rule of Construction.—Nothing in sub-
7	section (a) shall be construed to prohibit the repair or re-
8	placement of fencing that was in existence on the date of
9	enactment of this Act around an area described in sub-
10	section (a).
