A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Chapter 60 of Title 36 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2 general provisions regarding local government provisions applicable to counties and
3 municipal corporations, so as to enable the governing authority of certain counties to further
4 regulate the use or ignition of consumer fireworks; to provide for related matters; to repeal
5 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 Chapter 60 of Title 36 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to general
9 provisions regarding local government provisions applicable to counties and municipal
10 corporations, is amended by adding a new subsection to Code Section 36-60-24, relating to
11 sale or use or ignition of consumer fireworks products, to read as follows:

12 "(d.1) Notwithstanding subsections (a) and (b) of this Code section, the governing
13 authorities within the Atlanta Regional Commission, including the Counties of Cherokee,
14 Clayton, Cobb, DeKalb, Douglas, Fayette, Fulton, Gwinnett, Henry, and Rockdale, may
15 further regulate the times for the use or ignition of consumer fireworks."

16 **SECTION 2.**

17 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
