## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 12 of Title 31 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 control of hazardous conditions, preventable diseases, and metabolic disorders, so as to
- 3 authorize certain minors to receive vaccinations without parental consent; to provide a
- 4 definition; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Chapter 12 of Title 31 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to control of
- 8 hazardous conditions, preventable diseases, and metabolic disorders, is amended by adding
- 9 a new Code section to read as follows:
- 10 "31-12-3.3.
- 11 (a) As used in this Code section the term 'vaccination' means the administration of a
- 12 vaccine to an individual to produce immunity to tetanus/diphtheria/pertussis,
- meningococcal disease, measles, mumps, measles/mumps/rubella, polio, Hepatitis B,
- 14 Hepatitis A, chicken pox, or human papillomavirus.
- 15 (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a minor who is 16 or 17 years of age shall
- be authorized to receive a vaccination without parental consent."

17 SECTION 2.

18 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
