#### 1 AN ACT concerning

# University System of Maryland, Morgan State University, and St. Mary's College of Maryland – Board Membership – Alterations

- 4 FOR the purpose of altering the membership of the Board of Regents of the University  $\mathbf{5}$ System of Maryland to increase the number of members, require that certain 6 members have backgrounds in certain activities, and require that certain members 7 attended certain institutions of higher education; altering the membership of the 8 Board of Regents of Morgan State University and the Board of Trustees of St. Mary's 9 College of Maryland to increase the number of members and require that certain 10 members have backgrounds in certain activities; providing for the initial 11 appointment of certain members of the Board of Regents of Morgan State University 12and the Board of Trustees of St. Mary's College of Maryland; and generally relating 13 to the membership of the Board of Regents of the University System of Maryland, the Board of Regents of Morgan State University, and the Board of Trustees of St. 14 15Mary's College of Maryland.
