4 (a) EXEMPTION FOR MEDICAL MARIHUANA.—Sec-5 tion 922 of title 18, United States Code, is amended— 6 (1) in subsection (d)(3), by inserting before the semicolon the following: "(except that an individual 7 8 shall not be treated as an unlawful user of or ad-9 dicted to any controlled substance based on the indi-10 vidual using marihuana for a medical purpose in ac-11 cordance with State law)"; and

(2) in subsection (g)(3), by inserting before the
semicolon the following: "(except that an individual
shall not be treated as an unlawful user of or addicted to any controlled substance based on the individual using marihuana for a medical purpose in accordance with State law)".
