A BILL

To reinstate and extend the deadline for commencement of construction of a hydroelectric project involving Jennings Randolph Dam.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. REINSTATEMENT AND EXTENSION OF TIME
- 4 FOR A FEDERAL ENERGY REGULATORY COM-
- 5 MISSION PROJECT INVOLVING JENNINGS
- 6 RANDOLPH DAM.
- 7 (a) Extension of Time.—Notwithstanding the time
- 8 period specified in section 13 of the Federal Power Act
- 9 (16 U.S.C. 806) that would otherwise apply to the Federal
- 10 Energy Regulatory Commission project numbered 12715
- 11 (referred to in this section as the "project"), the Federal
- 12 Energy Regulatory Commission (referred to in this section
- 13 as the "Commission") may, at the request of the licensee
- 14 for the project, and after reasonable notice, in accordance
- 15 with the good faith, due diligence, and public interest re-
- 16 quirements of, and the procedures of the Commission
- 17 under, that section, extend the time period during which
- 18 the licensee is required to commence the construction of
- 19 the project for not more than 3 consecutive 2-year periods
- 20 that begin on the date of the expiration of the extension
- 21 originally issued by the Commission.
- 22 (b) Obligation of Licensee.—Any obligation of
- 23 the licensee for the project for the payment of annual
- 24 charges under section 10(e) of the Federal Power Act (16
- 25 U.S.C. 803(e)) shall commence on the expiration of the

- 1 time period to commence construction of the project, as
- 2 extended by the Commission under subsection (a).
- 3 (c) Reinstatement of Expired License.—
- 4 (1) IN GENERAL.—If the period required for 5 the commencement of construction of the project has 6 expired before the date of enactment of this Act, the 7 Commission may reinstate the license effective as of 8 the date of the expiration of the license.
- 9 (2) EXTENSION.—If the Commission reinstates 10 the license under paragraph (1), the first extension 11 authorized under subsection (a) shall take effect on 12 the date of the expiration of the license.
