To extend a project of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission involving the Cannonsville Dam.

1	Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-					
2	tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,					
3	SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF TIME FOR A FEDERAL ENERGY					
4	REGULATORY COMMISSION PROJECT IN					
5	VOLVING CANNONSVILLE DAM.					
6	(a) In General.—Notwithstanding the time period					
7	specified in section 13 of the Federal Power Act (16					
8	U.S.C. 806) that would otherwise apply to the Federal E					
9	ergy Regulatory Commission project numbered 13287, th					
10	Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (referred to i					
11	this section as the "Commission") may, at the request of					
12	the licensee for the project, and after reasonable notice					
13	in accordance with the good faith, due diligence, and pul					
14	lic interest requirements of that section and the proce					
15	dures of the Commission under that section, extend the					
16	time period during which the licensee is required to com-					
17	mence construction of the project for up to 4 consecutive					
18	2-year periods after the required date of the commence-					
19	ment of construction described in Article 301 of the li-					
20	cense.					
21	(b) Reinstatement of Expired License.—					
22	(1) In general.—If the required date of the					
23	commencement of construction described in sub-					
24	section (a) has expired prior to the date of enact-					

- ment of this Act, the Commission may reinstate the
  license effective as of that date of expiration.
- (2) EXTENSION.—If the Commission reinstates
  the license under paragraph (1), the first extension
  authorized under subsection (a) shall take effect on
  the date of that expiration.
