A BILL

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Exposing the Financ-
- 5 ing of Human Trafficking Act".

1 SEC. 2. INCLUSION OF FINANCIAL CRIMINAL ACTIVITIES.

- 2 Subsection (b) of section 108 of the Trafficking Vic-
- 3 tims Protection Act of 2000 is amended by adding at the
- 4 end the following new paragraph:
- 5 "(13) Whether the government of the country
- 6 vigorously investigates, seeks to prevent, and pros-
- 7 ecutes financial criminal activities associated with
- 8 the facilitation of severe forms of trafficking in per-
- 9 sons.".
