## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 2 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 registration and licensing of motor vehicles, so as to allow for the waiver of certain
- 3 requirements for license plates relating to vehicles of state and political subdivisions; to
- 4 establish a special license plate honoring Georgia's working forests and the Georgia Forestry
- 5 Foundation; to change the amount dedicated to a sponsoring agency, fund, or nonprofit
- 6 corporation related to a special license plate promoting dog and cat sterilization; to provide
- 7 for related matters; to provide for compliance with constitutional requirements; to provide
- 8 for effective dates; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

10 SECTION 1.

- 11 Chapter 2 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to registration and
- 12 licensing of motor vehicles, is amended in Code Section 40-2-37, relating to registration and
- licensing of vehicles of state and political subdivisions, by revising subsection (c) as follows:
- 14 "(c) All license plates issued to government vehicles pursuant to this Code section shall
- be marked in such a manner as to indicate the specific type of governmental unit operating
- the vehicle. These markings shall be prominently displayed and shall consist of one of the
- 17 following appropriate legends: 'STATE,' 'CITY,' 'COUNTY,' 'AUTHORITY,' or 'BOARD.'
- 18 In addition, each such license plate shall bear a county identification strip indicating the
- county in which the vehicle is based except that vehicles owned by the state shall not be
- required to bear such county identification strip. The commissioner shall be authorized to
- 21 grant a waiver of the requirements of this subsection such that regular Georgia license
- 22 plates may be issued for any vehicle or vehicles owned by the State of Georgia, any
- 23 municipality of this state, or any other political subdivision of this state upon finding
- 24 <u>issuance of such waiver to be in the best interest of public safety, public welfare, or</u>
- 25 <u>efficient administration."</u>

27 Said chapter is further amended in subsection (l) of Code Section 40-2-86, relating to special

28 license plates promoting and supporting certain beneficial projects, agencies, funds, or

- 29 nonprofit corporations, by revising paragraph (6) as follows:
- 30 "(6) Reserved. Special license plates promoting the dog and cat reproductive sterilization
- 31 support program of the Georgia Department of Agriculture. The funds raised by the sale
- 32 of these special license plates shall be disbursed to the Georgia Department of
- 33 Agriculture and shall be deposited in the special fund for support of the dog and cat
- 34 reproductive sterilization support program created by Code Section 4-15-1 and Article
- 35 III, Section IX, Paragraph VI(m) of the Constitution of the State of Georgia."

36 SECTION 3.

- 37 Said chapter is further amended in subsection (m) of Code Section 40-2-86, relating to
- 38 special license plates promoting and supporting certain beneficial projects, agencies, funds,
- 39 or nonprofit corporations, by adding a new paragraph to read as follows:
- 40 "(14) A special license plate honoring Georgia's working forests and the benefits they
- 41 provide to Georgians, with the words '#1 in Forestry' to be displayed across the bottom.
- The funds raised by the sale of this special license plate shall be disbursed as provided
- in paragraph (1) of this subsection to the Georgia Forestry Foundation."

44 SECTION 4.

- 45 Said chapter is further amended in subsection (n) of Code Section 40-2-86, relating to special
- 46 license plates promoting and supporting certain beneficial projects, agencies, funds, or
- 47 nonprofit corporations, by adding a new paragraph to read as follows:
- 48 "(7) A special license plate promoting the dog and cat reproductive sterilization support
- 49 program of the Department of Agriculture. The funds raised by the sale of this special
- 50 <u>license plate shall be disbursed to the Department of Agriculture and shall be deposited</u>
- in the special fund for support of the dog and cat reproductive sterilization support
- 52 program created by Code Section 4-15-1 and Article III, Section IX, Paragraph VI(m) of
- the Constitution of the State of Georgia."

54 SECTION 5.

- 55 In accordance with the requirements of Article III, Section IX, Paragraph VI(n) of the
- 56 Constitution of the State of Georgia, this Act shall not become law unless the requisite
- 57 two-thirds' majority vote in both the Senate and the House of Representatives is received.

58 **SECTION 6.** 

59 (a) Except as provided for in subsection (b) of this section, this Act shall become effective

- 60 on July 1, 2018.
- 61 (b) Section 3 of this Act shall become effective on July 1, 2019.

**SECTION 7.** 

63 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
