1	SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS FOR LEAD
2	EXPOSURE REGISTRY.
3	Section 2203(d) of the Water Infrastructure Im-
4	provements for the Nation Act (42 U.S.C. 300j–21(d)) is
5	amended—
6	(1) by redesignating paragraphs $(1)$ and $(2)$ as
7	subparagraphs (A) and (B), and adjusting the mar-
8	gins appropriately;
9	(2) by striking "There" and inserting the fol-
10	lowing:
11	"(1) FISCAL YEARS 2017 THROUGH 2021.—
12	There"; and
13	(3) by adding at the end the following:
14	"(2) FISCAL YEARS 2022 THROUGH 2031.—
15	There is authorized to be appropriated for the period
16	of fiscal years 2022 through 2031 $$50,000,000$ to
17	carry out subsection (b).".
