3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the President may not revoke a Presidential 4 5 permit, or any other permit or authorization, required pursuant to Executive Order No. 13337 (3 U.S.C. 301 note), 6 7 Executive Order No. 11423 (3 U.S.C. 301 note), Executive Order No. 12038 (43 Fed. Reg. 4957), Executive 8 9 Order No. 10485 (18 Fed. Reg. 5397), or any other Executive order for the construction, connection, operation, or 10 11 maintenance of an oil or natural gas pipeline or electric transmission facility, or any border-crossing facility there-12 13 of, unless such revocation is authorized by an Act of Con-14 gress.

### 15 (b) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

- 16 (1) BORDER-CROSSING FACILITY.—The term
  17 "border-crossing facility" means the portion of an oil
  18 or natural gas pipeline or electric transmission facil19 ity that is located at an international boundary of
  20 the United States.
- (2) NATURAL GAS.—The term "natural gas"
  has the meaning given such term in section 2 of the
  Natural Gas Act (15 U.S.C. 717a).

24 (3) OIL.—The term "oil" means petroleum or25 a petroleum product.
