- FOR the purpose of authorizing Baltimore County to tow, remove, or impound a vehicle owned by a new resident of the State who fails to register the vehicle with the Motor Vehicle Administration and display valid registration plates issued by the Administration within a certain time period; and generally relating to towing, removal, and impounding of improperly registered out—of—state vehicles in Baltimore County.
