#### 1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "VA Mission Telehealth3 Clarification Act".

SEC. 2. MODIFICATION OF LICENSURE REQUIREMENTS 4 5 FOR HEALTH CARE PROFESSIONALS PRO-6 VIDING TREATMENT VIA TELEMEDICINE. 7 Section 1730C(b) of title 38, United States Code, is amended to read as follows: 8 9 "(b) COVERED HEALTH CARE PROFESSIONALS.— For purposes of this section, a covered health care profes-10 sional is any of the following individuals: 11 12 "(1) A health care professional who— "(A) is an employee of the Department ap-13 14 pointed under section 7306, 7401, 7405, 7406, 15 or 7408 of this title or title 5; 16 "(B) is authorized by the Secretary to pro-17 vide health care under this chapter; "(C) is required to adhere to all standards 18 19 for quality relating to the provision of health 20 care in accordance with applicable policies of 21 the Department; and 22 "(D)(i) has an active, current, full, and 23 unrestricted license, registration, or certification 24 in a State to practice the health care profession 25 of the health care professional; or

1	"(ii) with respect to a health care profes-
2	sion listed under section 7402(b) of this title,
3	has the qualifications for such profession as set
4	forth by the Secretary.
5	((2) A postgraduate health care employee
6	who—
7	"(A) is appointed under section $7401(1)$ ,
8	7401(3), or 7405 of this title or title 5 for any
9	category of personnel described in paragraph
10	(1) or (3) of section 7401 of this title;
11	"(B) must obtain an active, current, full,
12	and unrestricted license, registration, or certifi-
13	cation or meet qualification standards set forth
14	by the Secretary within a specified time frame;
15	and
16	"(C) is under the clinical supervision of a
17	health care professional described in paragraph
18	(1).
19	"(3) A health professions trainee who—
20	"(A) is appointed under section 7405 or
21	7406 of this title; and
22	"(B) is under the clinical supervision of a
23	health care professional described in paragraph
24	(1).".
