## A BILL

To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to make members of health care sharing ministries eligible to establish health savings accounts.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- This Act may be cited as the "Faith in Health Sav-
- 5 ings Accounts Act of 2017".

- 4 (a) In General.—Section 223 of the Internal Rev-
- 5 enue Code of 1986 is amended by adding at the end the
- 6 following new subsection:
- 7 "(i) Application to Health Care Sharing Min-
- 8 ISTRIES.—For purposes of this section, membership in a
- 9 health care sharing ministry (as defined in section
- 10 5000A(d)(2)(B)(ii)) shall be treated as coverage under a
- 11 high deductible health plan.".
- 12 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 13 this section shall apply to taxable years beginning after
- 14 the date of the enactment of this Act.
