A BILL

To repeal the corporate alternative minimum tax.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Repealing the Ill-Con-
- 5 ceived and Problematic (RIP) Book Minimum Tax Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. REPEAL OF CORPORATE ALTERNATIVE MINIMUM
- 7 **TAX.**
- 8 (a) In General.—Section 10101 and section
- 9 13904(a) of Public Law 117–169 are repealed.

- 1 (b) Applicability.—The Internal Revenue Code of
- 2 1986 shall be applied and administered as if such sections
- 3 (and the amendments made by such sections) had not

4 been enacted.

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
