A BILL

To require the Secretary of the Treasury to harmonize the effective dates of all rules that the Secretary is required to issue under the Corporate Transparency Act, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Protecting Small Busi-
- 5 ness Information Act of 2023".

1	SEC. 2. HARMONIZING BENEFICIAL OWNERSHIP RULE-
2	MAKING EFFECTIVE DATES.
3	(a) In General.—In issuing the rules that the Sec-
4	retary of the Treasury is required to issue under the Cor-
5	porate Transparency Act (title LXIV of division F of Pub-
6	lic Law 116–283) (including under the amendments made
7	by that Act), the Secretary shall ensure that all such rules
8	take effect on the same date.
9	(b) Delay of Effective Dates.—A final rule
10	issued by the Secretary of the Treasury under the Cor-
11	porate Transparency Act (title LXIV of division F of Pub-
12	lic Law 116–283) (or under any amendment made by that
13	Act), including the final rule issued by the Secretary of
14	the Treasury entitled "Beneficial Ownership Information
15	Reporting Requirements" (87 Fed. Reg. 59498; published
16	September 30, 2022), shall not take effect until after the
17	date on which the Secretary of the Treasury certifies to
18	Congress, and makes that certification available to the
19	public, that—
20	(1) all final rules that the Secretary is required
21	to issue under that Act (including under the amend-
22	ments made by that Act) have been issued by the
23	Secretary; and
24	(2) all final rules described in paragraph (1)
25	will take affect on the same date
