1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "Supreme Court Ethics3 Act".

4 SEC. 2. CODE OF CONDUCT.

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 57 of title 28, United
6 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol7 lowing:

8 **"§964. Code of conduct**

9 "Not later than 1 year after the date of the enactment of this section, the Judicial Conference of the United 10 11 States shall issue a code of conduct, which applies to each justice and judge of the courts of the United States, except 12 that the code of conduct may include provisions that are 13 14 applicable only to certain categories of judges or justices.". 15 (b) TECHNICAL AND CONFORMING AMENDMENT.— 16 The table of sections for chapter 57 of title 28, United

17 States Code, is amended by adding after the item related

18 to section 963 the following:

"964. Code of conduct.".
