1 AN ACT concerning

2 State Boat Act – Privilege to Operate a Vessel – Suspension Authority

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Department of Natural Resources, in addition to 4 certain other applicable penalties, to suspend for up to a certain period of time the $\mathbf{5}$ privilege to operate a vessel on the waters of the State of a person who is convicted 6 of a certain violation; prohibiting a person from operating a vessel on the waters of 7 the State during a period of suspension of the privilege to operate a vessel on the 8 waters of the State; establishing certain timing and hearing requirements before the 9 suspension of the privilege to operate a vessel on the waters of the State; authorizing 10 the Department to suspend the privilege to operate a vessel on the waters of the 11 State without a hearing under certain circumstances; requiring the Department to 12adopt certain regulations; providing for the application of this Act; making this Act subject to a certain contingency; and generally relating to the suspension of a 13 14 privilege to operate a vessel on the waters of the State.
