A BILL

To amend the Financial Stability Act of 2010 to modify the requirements of stress tests.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- This Act may be cited as the "Main Street Regu-
- 5 latory Fairness Act".

1	SEC. 2. ENHANCED SUPERVISION AND PRUDENTIAL STAND-
2	ARDS FOR NONBANK FINANCIAL COMPANIES
3	SUPERVISED BY THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS
4	AND CERTAIN BANK HOLDING COMPANIES.
5	Section 165(i)(2)(A) of the Financial Stability Act of
6	2010 (12 U.S.C. 5365(i)) is amended—
7	(1) in the first sentence, by striking "semi-
8	annual" and inserting "periodic"; and
9	(2) in the second sentence—
10	(A) by striking "\$10,000,000,000" and in-
11	serting "\$50,000,000,000"; and
12	(B) by striking "annual" and inserting
13	"periodic".
