The House Committee on Health and Human Services offers the following substitute to HB 161:

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 16-13-32 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 transactions in drug related objects, so as to provide that employees and agents of harm
- 3 reduction organizations are not subject to certain offenses relating to hypodermic needles;
- 4 to provide for a definition; to provide for rules and regulations; to provide for related matters;
- 5 to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Code Section 16-13-32 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to transactions
- 9 in drug related objects, is amended by revising subsection (c) as follows:
- 10 "(c) It shall be unlawful for any person or corporation, other than a licensed pharmacist,
- a pharmacy intern or pharmacy extern as defined in Code Section 26-4-5, or a practitioner
- licensed to dispense dangerous drugs, or a person employed by or an agent of a harm
- 13 <u>reduction organization</u>, to sell, lend, rent, lease, give, exchange, or otherwise distribute to
- any person a hypodermic syringe or needle designed or marketed primarily for human use.
- 15 It shall be an affirmative defense that the hypodermic syringe or needle was marketed for
- a legitimate medical purpose. <u>As used in this subsection</u>, the term 'harm reduction
- 17 <u>organization' means an organization which provides direct assistance and services, such as</u>
- 18 syringe exchanges, drug treatment, and screening, to at-risk individuals to slow the spread
- 19 <u>of HIV and other infectious diseases among intravenous drug users. The Department of</u>
- 20 <u>Public Health shall be authorized to promulgate rules and regulations for the purpose of</u>
- 21 <u>supervising the activities of a harm reduction organization.</u>"

SECTION 2.

23 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
