- developed in the 19th Century by two Kentucky breeders named John W. Walker and

- 5 WHEREAS, the Treeing Walker Coonhound is a hunting breed known to chase
- 6 quarry into trees, thus giving hunters a clear shot at game; and
- WHEREAS, the Treeing Walker Coonhound is known for hunting raccoons, but are
- 8 also used for hunting other game, including animals ranging in size from small mammals
- 9 to bears; and
- WHEREAS, Treeing Walker Coonhounds are also good companion dogs, known
- for loyalty and intelligence, for their kindness to children and ability to get along with
- 12 other dogs; and
- WHEREAS, the Treeing Walker Coonhound became a recognized breed of the
- 14 American Kennel Club in January 2012;
- NOW, THEREFORE,
- 16 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
