A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act making appropriations for the operating and loan program expenses of state 2 government and for certain programs; capitalizing funds; making supplemental 3 appropriations, reappropriations, and other appropriations; making appropriations for 4 the operating and capital expenses of the state's integrated comprehensive mental health 5 program; and providing for an effective date."

* Section 1.
