- 12 WHEREAS, he was a member and past president of the Kiwanis Club, a charter member of
- Henry County Moose Lodge #2170, and delivered Meals on Wheels for over 20 years; and
- 14 WHEREAS, he was president of the HCSS Booster Club and president of the Henry County
- 15 Recreation Board and was instrumental in the creation of the Sunshine League Special Needs
- 16 Complex and bringing the ABC Roberto Clemente World Series to McDonough; and
- 17 WHEREAS, he coached numerous ball teams, umpired throughout the county, and was an
- 18 avid Georgia Tech fan, having received many awards, including being inducted into the
- 19 Henry County Sports Hall of Fame and the ASA Georgia Coaches/Umpire Hall of Fame, and
- 20 having Richard Craig Field at Alexander Park, the Craig/Lunsford Field at Henry County
- 21 High School, and the Richard Craig Park named in his honor; and
