A BILL

To bar Supreme Court decisions in certain Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act cases from citation.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. BARRING PPACA SUPREME COURT CASES 4 FROM CITATION.

5 Under Article 3, Section 2, which allows Congress to 6 provide exceptions and regulations for Supreme Court con-7 sideration of cases and controversies, the following cases 8 are barred from citation for the purpose of precedence in 9 all future cases after enactment: Nat'l Fed'n of Indep. 10 Bus. v. Sebelius, 132 S. Ct. 2566, 2573, 183 L. Ed. 2d 450 (2012) and King v. Burwell, 135 S. Ct. 2480, 2485,
192 L. Ed. 2d 483 (2015) and Burwell v. Hobby Lobby
Stores Inc., 134 S. Ct. 2751, 2782, 189 L. Ed. 2d 675
(2014).
