### **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Protect Our Military

5 Families' 2nd Amendment Rights Act".

1 SEC. 2. RECEIPT OF FIREARM OR AMMUNITION BY SPOUSE 2 OF MEMBER OF THE ARMED FORCES AT A 3 DUTY STATION OF THE MEMBER OUTSIDE 4 THE UNITED STATES. 5 Section 925(a)(3) of title 18, United States Code, is 6 amended-7 (1) by inserting "or to the spouse of such a 8 member" before "or to"; (2) by striking "members," and inserting 9 "members and spouses,"; 10 (3) by striking "members or" and inserting 11 12 "members, spouses, or"; and 13 (4) by striking "member or" and inserting "member, spouse, or". 14 15 SEC. 3. RESIDENCY OF SPOUSES OF MEMBERS OF THE 16 ARMED FORCES TO BE DETERMINED ON THE 17 SAME BASIS AS THE RESIDENCY OF SUCH 18 MEMBERS FOR PURPOSES OF FEDERAL FIRE-19 ARMS LAWS. 20 Section 921 of title 18, United States Code, is 21 amended by striking subsection (b) and inserting the fol-22 lowing: 23 "(b) For purposes of this chapter, a member of the 24 Armed Forces on active duty, or a spouse of such a mem-25 ber, is a resident of—

"(1) the State in which the member or spouse 1 2 maintains legal residence; "(2) the State in which the permanent duty 3 station of the member is located; and 4 "(3) the State in which the member maintains 5 6 a place of abode from which the member commutes 7 each day to the permanent duty station of the mem-8 ber.". 9 SEC. 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.

10 The amendments made by this Act shall apply to con-11 duct that occurs 180 days after the date of enactment of12 this Act.
