A BILL

To reduce, from 21 years of age to 18 years of age, the minimum age at which a person may obtain a handgun from a Federal firearms licensee.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Second Amendment
5 Mandates Equality Act” or the “SAME Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. MINIMUM AGE FOR OBTAINING A HANDGUN FROM**
7 **A FEDERAL FIREARMS LICENSEE.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 922(b)(1) of title 18,
9 United States Code, is amended by striking “, and, if the

1 firearm, or ammunition is other than a shotgun or rifle,
2 or ammunition for a shotgun or rifle, to any individual
3 who the licensee knows or has reasonable cause to believe
4 is less than twenty-one years of age”.

5 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section 922(c)(1)
6 of such title is amended by striking “, in the case of any
7 firearm other than a shotgun or a rifle, I am twenty-one
8 years or more of age, or that, in the case of a shotgun
9 or a rifle,”.

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
