## House Bill 2089

Sponsored by Representatives LININGER, GOMBERG, SMITH G (Presession filed.)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Allows liquor stores and distillery retail outlet agents to sell vermouth.

1	A BILL FOR AN ACT
<b>2</b>	Relating to vermouth sales by retail sellers of distilled liquor.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2017 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 471.
5	SECTION 2. (1) As used in this section:
6	(a) "Stock keeping unit" means a product that is assigned a specific identification code,
7	which states the type, size, brand or other inventory tracking information for the product.
8	(b) "Vermouth" means fortified wine that is flavored with botanicals.
9	(2) Notwithstanding ORS 471.230, a distillery retail outlet agent appointed under ORS
10	471.230 or a store established under ORS 471.750 may sell vermouth at retail for off-premises
11	consumption as provided under this section without holding an off-premises sales license.
12	Vermouth sold under this section must be in factory-sealed containers. A distillery retail
13	outlet agent or store may not offer more than 20 stock keeping units of vermouth for sale
14	under this section.
15	(3) A distillery retail outlet agent may sell vermouth under this section at the licensed
16	premises of the distillery or at a location described in ORS 471.230 (2) where the agent offers
17	tastings.
18	(4) Except as provided in this section, vermouth sales under this section are subject to

the restrictions and requirements imposed under this chapter and Oregon Liquor Control

Commission rules for retail sales of wine by an off-premises sales licensee.
