A BILL

To authorize State opioid response grants, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Combating Meth and
- 5 Cocaine Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. STATE OPIOID RESPONSE GRANTS.
- 7 (a) AUTHORIZATION.—The Assistant Secretary for
- 8 Mental Health and Substance Use may award opioid re-
- 9 sponse grants to States.
- 10 (b) Prevention and Treatment Activities.—A
- 11 State may use the funds awarded through a grant under

1	subsection (a) to carry out prevention and treatment ac-
2	tivities with respect to opioid use disorders, which may in-
3	clude—
4	(1) education regarding opioid use disorders;
5	(2) treatment (including the provision of medi-
6	cation) for opioid use disorders;
7	(3) behavioral health services for individuals in
8	opioid treatment programs;
9	(4) referral to treatment services for individuals
10	with an opioid use disorder;
11	(5) recovery support for individuals with an
12	opioid use disorder;
13	(6) medical screening associated with such
14	treatment; and
15	(7) preventing or treating the abuse of
16	psychostimulants, such as cocaine or methamphet-
17	amine.
18	(c) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There is
19	authorized to be appropriated \$500,000,000 for each of
20	fiscal years 2020 through 2024 for the purpose of carrying
21	out this section.
