3 (b) PUBLIC ACCESS.—Section 200306 of title 54,
4 United States Code, is amended by adding at the end the
5 following:

6 "(c) PUBLIC ACCESS.—Not less than 1.5 percent of 7 amounts made available for expenditure in any fiscal year 8 under section 200303, or \$10,000,000, whichever is great-9 er, shall be used for projects that secure recreational pub-10 lic access to existing Federal public land for hunting, fish-11 ing, and other recreational purposes.".
