1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "Moving Americans Pri-3 vacy Protection Act".

4 SEC. 2. PROTECTION OF PERSONALLY IDENTIFIABLE IN5 FORMATION.

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 431(c)(2) of the Tariff
7 Act of 1930 (19 U.S.C. 1431(c)(2)) is amended to read
8 as follows:

9 "(2)(A) The information listed in paragraph (1) shall
10 not be available for public disclosure if—

"(i) the Secretary of the Treasury makes an affirmative finding on a shipment-by-shipment basis
that disclosure is likely to pose a threat of personal
injury or property damage; or

15 "(ii) the information is exempt under the provi16 sions of section 552(b)(1) of title 5, United States
17 Code.

18 "(B) The Secretary shall ensure that any personally 19 identifiable information, including Social Security account 20 numbers and passport numbers, is removed from any 21 manifest signed, produced, delivered, or electronically 22 transmitted under this section before access to the mani-23 fest is provided to the public.". (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
 subsection (a) shall take effect on the date that is 30 days
 after the date of the enactment of this Act.
