

In the Senate of the United States,

November 12, 2019.

Resolved, That the bill from the House of Representatives (H.R. 1865) entitled “An Act to require the Secretary of the Treasury to mint a coin in commemoration of the opening of the National Law Enforcement Museum in the District of Columbia, and for other purposes.”, do pass with the following

AMENDMENT:

At the end, add the following:

1 ***SEC. 9. FINANCIAL ASSURANCES.***

2 *The Secretary shall take such actions as may be nec-*
3 *essary to ensure that—*

4 *(1) minting and issuing coins under this Act*
5 *will not result in any net cost to the United States*
6 *Government; and*

7 *(2) no funds, including applicable surcharges,*
8 *are disbursed to any recipient designated in section*
9 *7 until the total cost of designing and issuing all of*

1 *the coins authorized by this Act (including labor, ma-*
2 *terials, dies, use of machinery, overhead expenses,*
3 *marketing, and shipping) is recovered by the United*
4 *States Treasury, consistent with sections 5112(m) and*
5 *5134(f) of title 31, United States Code.*
