AN ACT

1 Amending Title 35 (Health and Safety) of the Pennsylvania
2 Consolidated Statutes, in miscellaneous provisions, providing
3 for exemption OF RECORDS FROM ACCESS. <--

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Title 35 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:

8 § 7715. Exemption OF RECORDS FROM ACCESS. <--

9 A RECORDS OF A volunteer EMS company, volunteer fire company <--
10 or a volunteer rescue company, as those terms are defined in
11 section 7802 (relating to definitions), shall not be subject to <--
12 ARE EXEMPT FROM ACCESS UNDER the provisions of the act of <--
13 February 14, 2008 (P.L.6, No.3), known as the Right-to-Know
14 Law-, EXCEPT THAT SECTION 506(D) OF THE RIGHT-TO-KNOW LAW SHALL <--
15 APPLY TO A VOLUNTEER EMS COMPANY, VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANY OR A
16 VOLUNTEER RESCUE COMPANY THAT CONTRACTS WITH A COMMONWEALTH

1 AGENCY OR LOCAL AGENCY.

2 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
