1 (b) The State shall bear the nonfederal portion of the administrative costs of the 2 Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program for each county.

3 (c) Each local department shall administer the Supplemental Nutrition 4 Assistance Program:

(1) under the supervision and control of the Department; and

(2) in accordance with the regulations of the Department and federal law.

7 (d) If a household includes an individual who is at least [62] **60** years old and 8 receives a federally funded benefit in an amount less than [\$30] **\$45** per month under the 9 Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program, the State shall provide a supplement to 10 increase the total benefit to [\$30] **\$45** per month.

11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 12 October 1, 2022.
