## A BILL

To clarify the applicability of certain parity provisions to mental health and substance use disorder telehealth benefits.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Telemental Health
- 5 Parity Act of 2022".

1	SEC. 2. CLARIFYING THE APPLICABILITY OF CERTAIN PAR-
2	ITY PROVISIONS TO MENTAL HEALTH AND
3	SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER TELEHEALTH
4	BENEFITS.
5	The provisions of sections 2726 of the Public Health
6	Service Act (42 U.S.C. 300gg–26), 712 of the Employee
7	Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (29 U.S.C.
8	1185a), and 9812 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986
9	shall apply to benefits for mental health or substance use
10	disorder services furnished via telehealth in the same man-
11	ner as such provisions apply to benefits for mental health
12	or substance use disorder services that are furnished in-
13	person.
