A BILL

To designate the community-based outpatient clinic of the Department of Veterans Affairs in Bozeman, Montana, as the “Travis W. Atkins Department of Veterans Affairs Clinic”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF TRAVIS W. ATKINS DEPART-**
4 **MENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS CLINIC IN**
5 **BOZEMAN, MONTANA.**

6 (a) DESIGNATION.—The community-based outpatient
7 clinic of the Department of Veterans Affairs located at
8 300 North Willson Avenue, Bozeman, Montana, shall after

1 the date of the enactment of this Act be known and des-
2 ignated as the “Travis W. Atkins Department of Veterans
3 Affairs Clinic” or the “Travis W. Atkins VA Clinic”.

4 (b) REFERENCE.—Any reference in any law, regula-
5 tion, map, document, paper, or other record of the United
6 States to the community-based outpatient clinic referred
7 to in subsection (a) shall be considered to be a reference
8 to the Travis W. Atkins Department of Veterans Affairs
9 Clinic.
