- To amend the State Department Basic Authorities Act of 1956 to authorize rewards for thwarting wildlife trafficking linked to transnational organized crime, and for other purposes.

 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "Rescuing Animals3 With Rewards Act of 2018" or the "RAWR Act".

4 SEC. 2. FINDINGS; SENSE OF CONGRESS.

5 (a) FINDINGS.—Congress finds the following:

6 (1) Wildlife trafficking is a major transnational 7 crime that is estimated to generate over \$10 billion 8 a year in illegal profits and which is increasingly 9 perpetrated by organized, sophisticated criminal en-10 terprises, including known terrorist organizations.

(2) Wildlife trafficking not only threatens endangered species worldwide, but also jeopardizes
local security, spreads disease, undermines rule of
law, fuels corruption, and damages economic development.

16 (3) Combating wildlife trafficking requires a co17 ordinated and sustained approach at the global, re18 gional, national, and local levels.

19 (4) Congress stated in the Eliminate, Neu-20 tralize, and Disrupt Wildlife Trafficking Act of 2016 21 that it is the policy of the United States to take im-22 mediate actions to stop the illegal global trade in 23 wildlife and wildlife products and associated 24 transnational organized crime.

25 (b) SENSE OF CONGRESS.—It is the sense of Con26 gress that the Department of State's rewards program is

a powerful tool in combating sophisticated international
 crime and that the Department of State and Federal law
 enforcement should work in concert to offer rewards that
 target wildlife traffickers.

11 7601(12); Public Law 114–231)) and" after "includes".
