13 14	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
15	Article - Public Safety

17 (a) A permit expires on the last day of the holder's birth month following [2] 5
18 years after the date the permit is issued.

(b) Subject to subsection (c) of this section, a permit may be renewed for successive periods of [3] 5 years each if, at the time of an application for renewal, the applicant possesses the qualifications for the issuance of a permit and pays the renewal fee stated in this subtitle.

- 1 (c) A person who applies for a renewal of a permit is not required to be 2 fingerprinted unless the Secretary requires a set of the person's fingerprints to resolve a 3 question of the person's identity.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 5 October 1, 2017.
