

1 A RESOLUTION recognizing February as Career and Technical Education Month
2 in Kentucky.

3 WHEREAS, the Association for Career and Technical Education established the
4 theme "Celebrate Today, Own Tomorrow!" for Career and Technical Education Month in
5 February 2020; and

7 commemorates Career and Technical Education Month with CTE Student Leadership
8 Day on February 11, 2020; and

18 from Pulaski County; Dalton Green, National DECA Central Region Vice President,
19 from Green County; and Justin Newton, SkillsUSA National High School Treasurer,
20 from Webster County, represent all Career and Technical Student Organization members
