Mr. EMMER introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Education and Labor

A BILL

To amend the National and Community Service Act of 1990 to clarify that an individual may receive certain benefits for more than 4 terms of service for compelling reasons.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Term Extension for
5 AmeriCorps Members Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. WAIVERS.**

7 Section 139(b) of the National and Community Serv-
8 ice Act of 1990 (42 U.S.C. 12593(b)) is amended by add-
9 ing at the end the following:

1 “(5) WAIVERS FOR COMPELLING PURPOSES.—

2 “(A) EXTENSION.—A State Commission
3 on National and Community Service for the
4 State in which a national service program is
5 being carried out may authorize, for compelling
6 circumstances, an individual in an approved na-
7 tional service position may continue a service
8 for more than 4 terms.

9 “(B) BENEFITS.—An individual per-
10 forming service under this paragraph may con-
11 tinue to receive a living allowance and other
12 benefits under section 12594 of this title but
13 may not receive an additional national service
14 educational award under section 12595 of this
15 title.”.
