A BILL

To amend the National and Community Service Act of 1990 to clarify that an individual may receive certain benefits for more than 4 terms of service for compelling reasons.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Term Extension for
- 5 AmeriCorps Members Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. WAIVERS.
- 7 Section 139(b) of the National and Community Serv-
- 8 ice Act of 1990 (42 U.S.C. 12593(b)) is amended by add-
- 9 ing at the end the following:

1	"(5) Waivers for compelling purposes.—
2	"(A) Extension.—A State Commission
3	on National and Community Service for the
4	State in which a national service program is
5	being carried out may authorize, for compelling
5	circumstances, an individual in an approved na-
7	tional service position may continue a service
8	for more than 4 terms.
9	"(B) Benefits.—An individual per-

"(B) Benefits.—An individual performing service under this paragraph may continue to receive a living allowance and other benefits under section 12594 of this title but may not receive an additional national service educational award under section 12595 of this title.".
