SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 16 Article Education
- 17 3–902.

1 **SUBSECTION, A** student member who completes a full term on the county board shall [be 2 granted a scholarship of:

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, § 35 24of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to the salary 25or compensation of the president and members of the Montgomery County Board of 2627Education while serving in a term of office beginning before the effective date of this Act, 28but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or compensation of the president and 29members of the Montgomery County Board of Education shall take effect at the beginning of the next following term of office. This limitation does not apply to an individual appointed 30 or elected after the effective date of this Act to fill out an unexpired term. 31

32 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 33 1, 2020.
