## A BILL

- To amend title 38, United States Code, to improve the work-study allowance program administered by the Secretary of Veterans Affairs, and for other purposes.
  - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
  - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

## **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "GI Bill Work Study

5 Improvement Act of 2019".

6 SEC. 2. IMPROVEMENT TO WORK-STUDY ALLOWANCE PRO-7 GRAM.

8 (a) PAYMENT OF ALLOWANCE.—Subsection (a) of
9 section 3485 of title 38, United States Code, is amended—

(1) in paragraph (1), by striking "Individuals"
 and inserting "In accordance with paragraph (4), in dividuals";

4 (2) by redesignating paragraphs (4), (5), and
5 (6) as paragraphs (5), (6), and (7), respectively; and
6 (3) by inserting after paragraph (3) the fol7 lowing new paragraph:

8 "(4)(A) The Secretary shall carry out this section by 9 providing to an educational institution an annual amount 10 for the institution to use in paying work-study allowance 11 under paragraph (1) to individuals enrolled at the institu-12 tion.

"(B) With respect to an educational institution that
participated in the work-study program under this section
during the academic year beginning August 1, 2018, the
Secretary shall determine the annual amount to provide
to the educational institution under subparagraph (A) as
follows:

"(i) For the academic year beginning August 1,
20 2020, the amount shall be the total amount the Sec21 retary paid under this section to individuals enrolled
22 at such educational institution during the academic
23 year beginning August 1, 2018.

24 "(ii) Except as provided by subparagraph
25 (D)(ii), for each academic year beginning on or after

August 1, 2021, the amount shall be the total
 amount the educational institution paid under this
 section for work-study allowance to individuals en rolled at such educational institution during the pre vious academic year in which individuals participated
 in the work-study program.

7 "(C) With respect to an educational institution that
8 did not participate in the work-study program under this
9 section during the academic year beginning August 1,
10 2018, the Secretary shall determine the annual amount
11 to provide to the educational institution under subpara12 graph (A) as follows:

"(i) For the first academic year in which the
educational institution participates in the work-study
program beginning on or after August 1, 2020, the
amount shall be an amount the Secretary determines
appropriate based on an amount provided to a similar educational institution pursuant to subparagraph
(B).

"(ii) Except as provided by subparagraph
(D)(ii), for each academic year occurring after the
academic year specified in clause (i), the amount
shall be the total amount the educational institution
paid under this section for work-study allowance to
individuals enrolled at such educational institution

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1	during the previous academic year in which individ-
2	uals enrolled at such educational institution partici-
3	pated in the work-study program.
4	"(D)(i) Except as provided in clause (ii), if the Sec-
5	retary provides an annual amount to an educational insti-
6	tution under subparagraph (B) or (C) that is more than
7	the total amount the educational institution pays to indi-
8	viduals under paragraph (1)—
9	((I) the educational institution shall return to
10	the Secretary the unpaid amount; and
11	"(II) the Secretary shall transfer the returned
12	amount into the general fund of the Treasury.
13	"(ii)(I) If the annual amount provided to an edu-
14	cational institution under subparagraph (B) or (C) is
15	more, but less than 10 percent more, than the total
16	amount the educational institution pays to individuals
17	under paragraph (1), and the educational institution plans
18	to participate in the work-study program under this sec-
19	tion during the subsequent academic year, the educational
20	institution may retain the amount of the overpayment if
21	the educational institution notifies the Secretary of the
22	amount of the overpayment and the intention of the edu-
23	cational institution to retain such amount.
24	"(II) Any amount retained by an educational institu-

25 tion under this clause may only be used by the educational

institution to provide work-study allowance to individuals
 enrolled at the educational institution.

"(iii) At any time an educational institution may request the Secretary to increase the annual amount that
the Secretary provides the educational institution under
subparagraph (B) or (C).

7 "(E) Pursuant to section 3690(c), section 3693, and
8 other provisions of chapter 36 of this title, the Secretary
9 shall ensure that an educational institution carries out the
10 work-study allowance program in compliance with this sec11 tion.".

12 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Subsection (e)(1)
13 of such section is amended by striking "subsection (a)(4)"
14 and inserting "subsection (a)(5)".

(c) APPLICATION.—The amendments made by this
section shall apply with respect to a quarter, semester, or
term, as applicable, commencing on or after August 1,
2020.

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
